Re: Warm Weather Attire for Students

Dear Parent/Guardian,

With the warm weather upon us, please ensure that your middle school child wears appropriate attire during school hours. Some clothing items worn by students pose a distraction as well as a safety hazard. We ask that you please refrain from sending your child to school wearing spaghetti straps, short skirts and shorts, or unsafe shoes such as soft-soled or slippers to school. Specifically, we ask that students wear shorts/skirts that are at least mid-thigh in length. Undergarments must not be visible and ultra-sheer and see-through clothing must not be worn. As further examples, tops, dresses and jumpsuits must not be worn off-the-shoulder, not be strapless or one-shouldered, and halter tops/tube tops not be worn.

Please do not hesitate to access our District Policy/Regulation #5511 for further criteria regarding appropriate attire in school that applies to both girls and boys. Thank you for helping to ensure that the Middle School remains a safe and appropriate environment for all our adolescent students.
