Many students with disabilities have behaviors that interfere with learning and social relationships. Sometimes, behaviors can be dangerous to the child or to others and left untreated, may put the child at increased risks. In this 90-minute program, attendees will learn about proactive strategies to address the needs of students with disabilities who also have behavioral difficulties, including IEP accommodations, social skills teaching and how to limit exposure to school discipline policies. Participants will also learn about what to do if a child faces disciplinary responses to behaviors that may be due to his or her disability.
