#### **Definitions**



Desired outcomes necessary to fulfill the mission. They are positive, student-centered, and aspirational.





**Objectives** are the various means to accomplish goals. They are specific, tactical, and descriptive.





**HOW** – Specific tasks essential to carrying out the objectives. Written by administration.



#### **Components of Goal Statement**

TO

Action verb

 Increase, develop, obtain, complete, etc. To create

WHAT

- Statement of nouns
  - What you will impact

a safe and secure learning environment

SO THAT

What the outcome will do for you

#### **GOAL WRITING PROCESS**

#### **Sample Goal Area:**

#### Facilities and Finance/Safety and Security

#### Visions (from Meeting 2)

- Interactive learning space open floor plans
- Expand school choice program
- Virtual classrooms
- Safe learning environment
- Equitable distribution of funds for facilities
- State-of-the-art facilities
- All "green" facilities

#### Strengths (from Meeting 1)

- Safety and security
- Facilities improvements
- Building configurations
- Class size space

#### **Challenges**

- Environmental concerns
- Older buildings
- Safety and security
- Mandates and resources drain



#### **GOAL WRITING PROCESS**

#### **Sample Goal Statement**

Goal Area: Facilities and Finance/Safety and Security

Goal Statement: Create a safe and secure learning environment equipped to deliver 21<sup>st</sup> century programs.

#### **Objectives:**

- Upgrade facilities to be more energy and cost efficient
- Increase internal and external security at all schools
- Upgrade existing facilities to be more structurally modernized.



#### **Group Work**
