JULY 2021 - DECEMBER 2021 OUT OF NETWORK CLAIMS

Diane can assist you with contacting Horizon to reprocess the claims so they accurately reflect any out-of-network expenses that incurred for the first half of 2021 under Aetna.

LIFE-CHANGING EVENTS

If you experience a qualifying event, such as marriage, divorce, the birth of a child, etc., please notify Manal Fouad (mfouad@jefftwp.org) within 60 days of the event. If you don't report the event within 60 days, you will not be able to make any changes to your benefits until the next Open Enrollment period.

CHANGES IN COVERAGE FOR EMPLOYEES WHO WAIVE BENEFITS

If you waive medical benefits and experience a change in your health care coverage, please notify Manal Fouad (mfouad@jefftwp.org) as soon as possible. This will allow any waiver payment adjustments to be made in a timely manner.

FEBRUARY 2022 PREMIUM HOLIDAY

As you may know, the School Employee Health Benefit Plan "SEHBP" Commission voted on August 5, 2021, to approve a contribution "holiday" **Employees** February 2022. enrolled in the SEHBP are not required to make a contribution toward medical health coverage for the month of February 2022. As a result, employee benefit contributions will be greatly reduced for 10-month employees or eliminated for 12-month employees for the February 15th and February 28th pay cycles. Ten-month employees reduced amount a the required related to contribution for July & August coverage that is collected prorata throughout the school year.
