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


For 2021, the Children's System of Care (CSOC) will be providing Summer Camp Services to eligible children, youth, and young adults under 21 years of age. These services include Financial Support toward Summer Camp Tuition and One-to-One Aide Services for Summer Camp.

Completed applications for CSOC Summer Camp Services (Financial Support toward Summer Camp Tuition and One-to-One Aide Services for Summer Camp) must be postmarked or received by PerformCare no later than April 30, 2021. Your application must be complete for the services requested for it to be considered.


CSOC Summer Camp Services Checklist

Summer Camp

- Read the Summer Camp Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ): [bit.ly/csoccampfaqs](#)
- Make sure your child's camp is a CSOC camp provider: [bit.ly/csokcamp](#)
- Ask the camp for an acceptance letter (on camp letterhead). A copy of camp acceptance letter from the CSOC-Qualified Camp should be submitted along with your application.
- Complete Part A of the CSOC Summer Camp Application: Paper Application: [bit.ly/csoccamppaper](#) | Apply online: [bit.ly/csoccamponline](#). You do not need to complete Part B if you are requesting One-to-One Aide Services.
- Complete the "Child Adaptive Behavior Summary" as part of the application. The CABs is intended to gather information about your child's typical functioning during the last school year. It should reflect, to the extent possible, the child's behavior in a variety of settings at home, in school, and in the community. It should provide a broad picture of the impact of the child's disability on daily life for both the child and the parent/caregiver.
- If applicable, complete Part B of the application if your loved one requires a one-to-one aide.
- If a one-to-one aide is required, complete the "Child Adaptive Behavior Summary" (CABS) in conjunction with the camp provider.
- Application(s) must be completed and postmarked to PerformCare by **April 30th, 2021**.

CSOC Summer Camp Services 2021: A Guide For Families

Important Information

Financial Support toward Summer Camp Tuition is for the camp's daily rate, not to exceed \$80.00 per day for day camp for a maximum of 10 days) and not to exceed \$13.00 per day for overnight camp for a maximum of 10 days. Financial support toward the cost of summer camp not covered by CSOC.

You will need your youth CYBER ID number in order to contact PerformCare at 1-877-452-7624.

If your child is already registered with PerformCare with a CYBER ID, you can apply online. Enter your CYBER ID on the Family Portal website, here: [bit.ly/performcarefamilyportal](#)

Deadline

Completed applications for Financial Support toward Summer Camp Tuition One-to-One Aide Services must be received by PerformCare, postmarked or received by PerformCare no later than April 30th, 2021. Applications, including supporting documentation, MUST be complete in order to be considered. Necessary paperwork is to be submitted along with your application.

Camp Eligibility

A youth can be considered for CSOC financial support toward Summer Camp Tuition if all of the following conditions are met:

- Your child receives financial assistance only during the period of time in which they are not in school (e.g., summer extended school year (ESY) program).
- The youth is deemed eligible for One-to-One Aide Services (DD services).
- The youth is between the ages of 21 and will not turn 21 before the end of the camp session selected for reimbursement.
- The youth resides in their own home or in a group home setting.

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Application Part A: Financial Support toward Summer Camp Tuition

1. Parents or guardians must register the youth with a CSOC-Qualified Camp Provider starting the application for CSOC-Qualified Day Camp Services.
2. The family is required to provide the following documentation to PerformCare:
 - a. Completed summer camp application and camp registration form or a Mail-in Application (On camp letterhead).
 - b. Individual is registered for a specific camp. Camps must be from the DCF qualified provider (PerformCare).
 - c. Your child does not need to complete Form B if you are requesting One-to-One Aide Services.

Application Part B: One-to-One Aide Services

1. If the CSOC-Qualified Camp you have selected has determined that your child will need a One-to-One Aide to participate in camp, you are required to complete Part B of the Application for CSOC-Qualified Day Camp Services.
 - a. You must have the camp provider meet complete the Child Adaptive Behavior Summary (CABS) together in Part B of the Application for CSOC-Qualified Day Camp Services.
 - b. The camp must retain a copy of the CABS.
 - c. Once One-to-One Aide Services are available for CSOC-Qualified Day Camps only.
