



Special Education Parent Advisory Group (SEPAG)

New Jersey Administrative Code 6A:14-1.2(h) states that:

“Each board of education shall ensure that a special education parent advisory group is in place in the district to provide input to the district on issues concerning students with disabilities.”

A SEPAG gives parents the opportunity to provide direct input to their school district about policy, programs, practices, and services that have an impact on students with disabilities and their families.

Who should attend a SEPAG meeting?

Parents and guardians of students eligible for or receiving services under an IEP, 504 Plan and I&RS, school leaders, including the District Supervisor of Special Education, teachers, Child Study Team members, and other school professionals; students, and former students; other parents committed to improving education in their district; and community leaders and other citizens.



In order to have an effective advisory group, the Jefferson Township SEPAG will need parent/guardian participants.

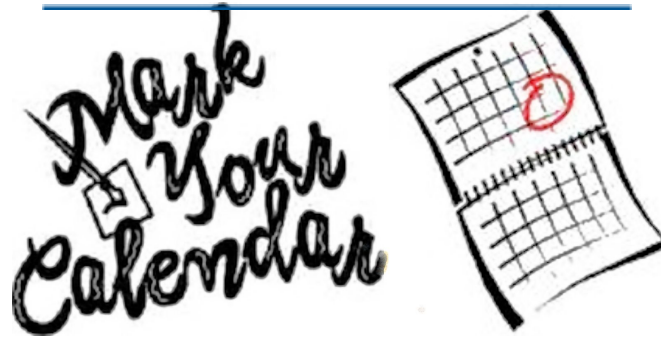
