January 2021 KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR

Kindergarten registration will be held at the Milton School and the Ellen T. Briggs School in Jefferson Township from March 1-12, 2021 by appointment only at the school your child will be attending. Your child does not need to be present during registration. As per District Policy 5112, *Entrance Age*, only those children who will be five years of age **before** October 1, 2021 will be eligible to enter kindergarten in September 2021.

REQUIREMENTS ARE:

1. Original Birth Certificate (with raised seal). Child must be 5 years of age prior to October 1, 2021.
2. Each Student must have a physical examination and provide examination documentation within 30 days upon enrollment/entry into school. The exam must have been completed within the year.
3. Complete immunization against DTaP (DTP): 4 Doses minimum, with 1 dose given on or after 4th birthday, or any 5 doses given at appropriate intervals.
4. Complete immunization against Polio: 3 doses minimum, with 1 dose given on or after 4th birthday, or any 4 doses given at appropriate intervals.
5. Complete immunization against Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR): 2 doses of a measles vaccine to be given on or after 1st birthday. First MMR vaccine given on or after 1 year of age, followed by measles containing vaccine, with vaccine doses separated by at least one month. Laboratory evidence of immunity is acceptable in lieu of receiving the second dose of measles, mumps or rubella vaccine.
6. Hepatitis B Vaccine: 3 doses appropriately spaced.
7. Varicella Vaccine: 1 dose given after 1st birthday. Laboratory evidence of immunity or statement of previous Varicella disease is acceptable.

(Doctor's or Health Department Certificate is required as written proof that the above are completed.)

8. Proof of Residence
 - a. Home Owners: mortgage statement or current Jefferson Township tax invoice
 - b. Renters: current rental agreement/lease AND current utility bill
9. Parent picture identification (i.e., driver's license).

Bring all of the required documentation with you to your appointment. Anyone failing to provide necessary documents will be asked to reschedule.

Appointments will be held outside of school hours and only one registrant will be permitted in the building at a time. As such, please arrive on time for your appointment. Masks must be worn at all times while in the building.

State Law prohibits the acceptance of any child who does not meet these requirements prior to the first day of entering school in September.
