

Grade 12 Options: Next Steps



Grade 12 Options: Important Factors to Consider

- 1. You are responsible for your own transportation.
- 2. You are responsible for scheduling your own courses.
- 3. You are responsible for maintaining passing grades in those courses.
- 4. You are treated as a college student and expected to act as such; your professors do not know you are in high school.
- 5. Your graduation depends on your successful completion of English, PE, Health, and Academy courses at your 12th Grade Option Site. A "C" or better is required for these courses.

Grade 12 Options: Important Factors to Consider

- 6. There is far less support at a college than at high school.
- 7. There are far fewer assignments/grade events factored into your final grade
- 8. Colleges do not always accept the transfer credits. (www.njtransfer.org)
- 9. Some college admissions departments require a heavier course-load for your Senior year than what MCST finances.
- 10. You must be independent, responsible, motivated & diligent to reap the benefits of taking dual ernollment courses (at a college).
