

Instructions for Connecting the Laptop to Your Home Network

Windows 10

Step 1

- Power on the laptop
- Log in using the student credentials provided
- Please note that the username for a Windows-based laptop does not contain the “@” symbol followed by our network domain jefftwp.org
- Username example: r Fleming1024
- Password example: flem1024
- All passwords are case sensitive
- Click on the icon “Other User” at the bottom left of the screen if the login window does not look similar to the example →



Step 2

- There are a few ways to access the Wi-Fi network settings
 - Click on the wireless icon on the system tray
 - Press F8 on the keyboard
 - Swipe left from the right side on the touch screen with your finger



Step 3

- If the settings menu does not display all of the icons click on “Expand”
- Make sure “Airplane mode” is set to off
- Click on the “Network” icon to display the available networks
- Select your home Wi-Fi network from the list
- Check the box to have the laptop connect to your wireless network automatically
- Click on Connect
- If you are prompted, enter the password for your wireless network
- Click Next
