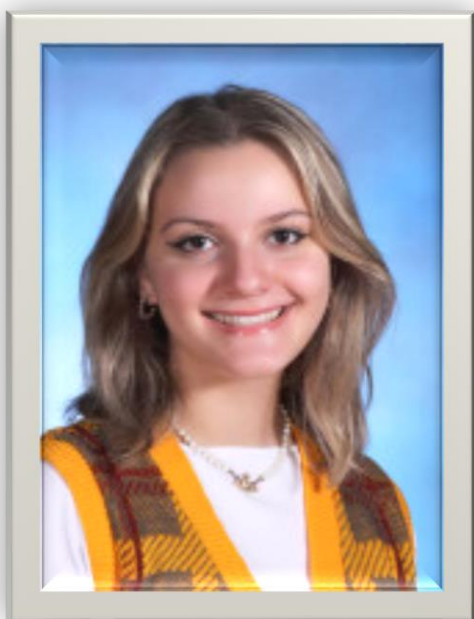
Blackwell Street Center for the Arts High School Student Art Show Update -

Academy of Environmental Science -

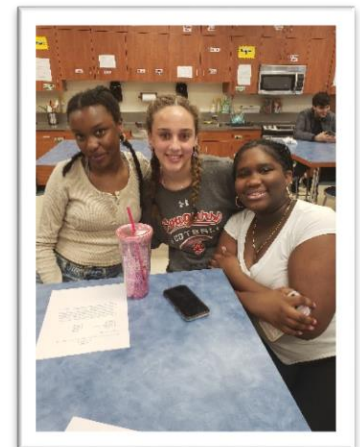
