  - Congratulations! The College Board is pleased to share the exciting news that your district has earned a position on the 10th Annual AP District Honor Roll! The annual AP District Honor Roll recognizes districts for increasing access to Advanced Placement course work while maintaining or increasing the percentage of students earning scores of 3 or higher on AP Exams.
