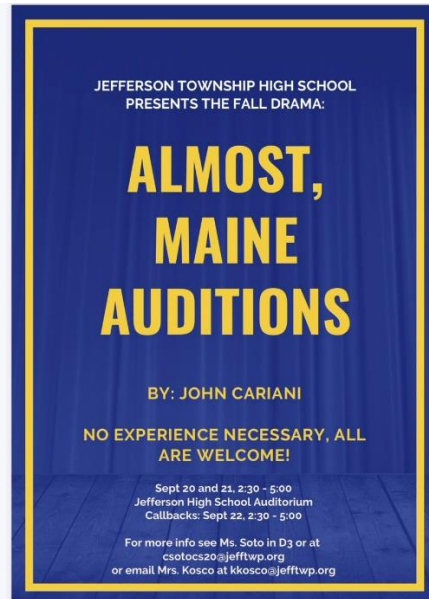


18-21 Program –
