In 1954 and being finalized in 1957 the Nash Corporation and Hudson company join together and form the American Motors Corporation starting the trademark


From 1957 to 1964 AMC sales sky rocket charting them at the third most popular car company behind ford and chevy

1964 to 1966 AMCs financial struggles begin they lose 12.6 million dollars of profit in 1966

1970s AMCS introduces there muscle car lines like the Javelin and AMX they also buy the Jeep name which just gets them by


Following they 1980s AMC is financially bankrupt and get bought out by Chrysler

In 2018 Chrysler canceled there ownership of the AmC trademark destroying the company and making it free to use.



- I usually post advertisements like this giving a little backstory of my design work and I try to relate a little to set a common trusting ground.











This designs prices are \$30 for a tee shirt \$15 for a mug/travel mug and \$20 for a poster






