25-26 Budget Challenges

- State Aid uncertainty
- Anticipated limited availability of Surplus (funds remaining at the end of the current year)
- Depletion of Reserves & Excess Surplus (funds remaining from 23-24 school year)
- Sustained upward pressure on expenditures far outpacing the rate of revenue growth
 - Insurance
 - Salaries
 - Transportation
 - Other goods & services

- Connected with a new advocacy group, The NJ Fair Funding
 Collective
- NJDOE School Funding Reform Act Outreach
