The American Sign Language honor society is celebrating "Deaf Culture Awareness" week. Did you know that The football huddle is credited to Gallaudet University and began in 1894. Gallaudet University was an all-deaf school, and their football team needed a way to protect their play calling from being intercepted. So, they formed a huddle, a close-knit circle of players, to prevent their opponents from seeing their signs when they were using American Sign Language to call plays. The huddle quickly became a standard practice in football and has been used ever since.
