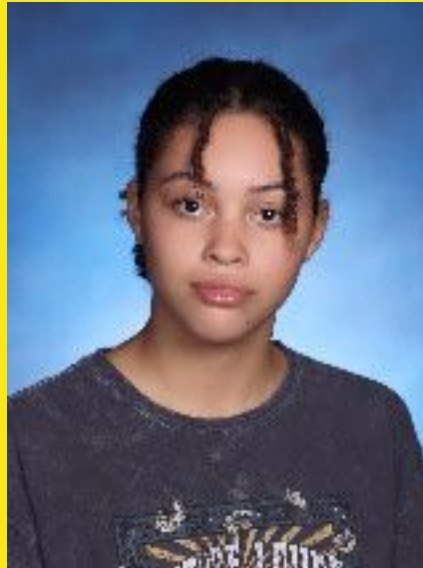
Elisa Martinez
