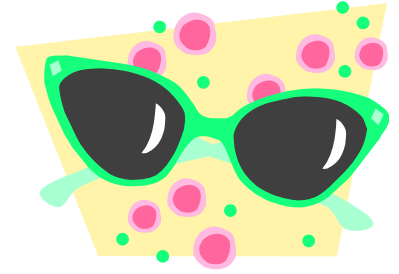


6th Grade Year-End Picnic



As a grade level, we will be holding an end-of-the-year picnic on **Monday, June 24th**. The planned activities will be during the day, from 8:45am until 11:55am, on the middle school back field.

All school rules will be enforced for this event, including dress code. However, hats are allowed and even suggested once we exit the building, because the weather will hopefully be warm and sunny. We suggest applying sunscreen before coming to school, and students with respiratory conditions, allergies, or asthma should be aware of the risk and come prepared. For those who have medical supplies here at the school, the nurse will be monitoring the event and prepare accordingly.

Anyone who pre-ordered a yearbook will have gotten it before the picnic and open sales will be occurring during lunch Wednesday the week before through Tuesday. Students may also bring some equipment to make the time enjoyable (i.e. – blankets/sheets to sit on, a football, etc.). However, we ask that there be no lacrosse equipment or baseball/softball bats, for safety reasons. Also, we ask that each student **come prepared with a WATER BOTTLE**, visibly labeled with his or her name. Students can refill these throughout the day.

Students will be provided with a lunch of pizza, chips, fruit, and ice cream. If you would like to assist in some way, we **are looking for help during the event** as well as **donations of paper plates & napkins, WATER jugs, gallon containers or larger, as well as SLICED ORANGES, GRAPES and INDIVIDUAL SNACK BAGS of chips or pretzels**. It should also be linked on each 6th grade teacher's Google Classroom for easy access. These items can be dropped off to room C5, **before Monday morning**.
