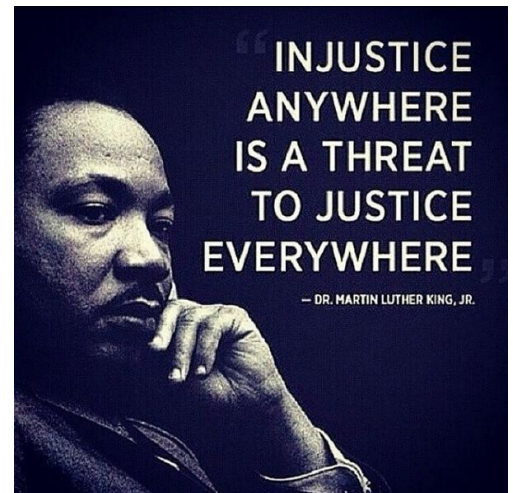


Dear Parents/Guardians of Sixth Grade Students:

The sixth grade students of Jefferson Township Middle School cordially invite you to our Civil Liberties “Hall of Fame” research presentations on **Friday, April 12th**, in the Media Center during your child’s regularly scheduled Language Arts class. **Please note the specific time of your child’s presentation below.**



Sixth graders were recently given an assignment to research an influential person who contributed to the social reform of civil liberties and the Civil Rights Movement during the 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> centuries, both for the minority races and gender equality. Students cooperatively and independently conducted research on this person and created a trifold project which includes an informative essay, a timeline, and related images. Students will act as experts about their assigned person during our “Hall of Fame” presentations and show their knowledge by responding to pre-arranged questions.

The students will be running continuous presentations around the Media Center for the full half hour block listed below. We ask that attendees plan to arrive no earlier than the scheduled start time, so as not to cause overcrowding in the previous class. **Friday, April 12th will be an “A” day.**
