P. NEW BUSINESS

- The Board discussed the following tentative dates for meetings regarding the proposed 2008-2009 budget:
 - o March 3, 2008 @ 8:00pm Special Meeting to Adopt Preliminary Budget
 - o March 26, 2008 @ 7:00pm Special Meeting and Public Hearing to Adopt Budget
- Mrs. Mastricola noted various differences in the school calendar for 2008-2009. The Board plans to adopt the calendar at the March Board of Education meeting.

Q. BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

- Mr. Cerny urged the public to get involved in the budget process and make informed decisions.
- Mrs. Castiglione commented on the "Wall of Hands" and movie night at Stanlick school. She also spoke of a discussion with a former student and his experiences in our school district.
- Mrs. Scott commented on a recently formed secondary school committee consisting of various counselors, students and teachers. Its purpose is to review policies and regulations and make recommendations to the Board of Education.
- Mr. Feldmann attended the Mardi Gras event at the high school.
- Many comments were made regarding the recent snow day and failure of the Global Connect system to work properly. The responsibility appears to fall with the telephone company; hopefully the situation has been rectified.

R. STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES

• Student Representative Craig Coehlo commented on various events at the high school including a fundraiser for a choir trip and the spring musical "Little Shop of Horrors".

S. COMMENTS FROM THE AUDIENCE

- Several comments were made regarding the Briggs roof. It was requested that the roof replacement take place ASAP.
- Allegations of headaches and mold were made.
- It is contended that 8 children were/are out of school because of illnesses such as pneumonia. The local health department has not been contacted, as it has no jurisdiction over this matter.
- It was suggested that 2 rooms be sampled for air quality to put rumors to rest.
- An issue was raised concerning a student who became ill while on a school bus. The bus driver had no telephone but did follow the proper protocol.
- It was suggested that an additional autism class be added.

- An audience member also suggested a dress down day on April 2 to mark World Awareness Autism Day.
- Several suggestions were made in regard to special education such as: start in-class support at lower grades and refine inclusion, add a Behaviorist to staff, that the extended school year be a more age appropriate program, and provide additional training for aides. It was also suggested that staff add a separate column to the JTSNAP newsletter.
- An audience member who served as a Board Member in a different town would like to see the budget pass.
- A Stanlick Room Mother suggested that all students receive a class list, not just classified. Also noted was the moving plea by Mr. DiColo to include classified students in the athletic programs.
