WHEREAS, all bids received at the second public bid opening substantially exceed the Board's cost estimate and appropriation for the Project; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-5 permits a board of education to negotiate a contract for a project where bids have been advertised and received on two occasions and the board of education has rejected such bids as being not reasonable as to price based on cost estimated prepared for or by the board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-22, the Board hereby rejects all bids received at the second bid opening on the basis that they are not reasonable as to price and that they substantially exceed the Board's cost estimate for the Project and substantially exceed the Board's appropriation for the Project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Business Administrator is authorized to return the bid securities to all bidders; and
