E. **SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT**

- Dr. Tierney reported on the Good News and Progress in Our Schools including PARCC readiness at Stanlick, Battle of the Books and Drama Club activities at Briggs, and “The Glammies” at the high school.

F. PRESENTATIONS

- Ms. Charlene Petersen of New Jersey School Boards Association presented the districts Strategic Plan, Final Report.

H. STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES

- Student Representative Alyssa Feldmann noted that everyone is looking forward to spring break. She also commented on the success of the “*Adam’s Family*” production and noted that spring sports are in full swing and the senior class is preparing for Project Graduation.

STATEMENT FROM DR. TIERNEY, SUPERINTENDENT

At this time, Dr. Tierney addressed concerns regarding the proposed 2017-2018 budget. He reported that the rumor regarding the district outsourcing any staff is not true. He also addressed the concerns about reduced staffing. Dr. Tierney reported the district has 26 staff members not returning in 2017-2018. Six of them are due to retirements, 3 have resigned, 14 have been RIF’d and 3 are non-renewed for performance. The district has seen a steady decrease in enrollment. He noted that if the declining enrollment trend continues, there is the possibility of additional reductions in future years. Class size will continue to be within district policy.

I. COMMITTEE REPORTS

- **Education Committee** – Mrs. Senatore reported the Committee met on April 3 and discussed revision updates for elementary report cards, ELA and math summer work, Grade 8 Algebra, and day and overnight field trip approval. The Committee also discussed the formation of the new ad hoc committee for human rights.
- **Policy and Personnel Committee** – Mr. Millar noted the Committee met on April 3 and reviewed all open positions within the district. Discussion took place regarding job descriptions and policy revision. Policies have been placed on the public agenda for action.
- **Negotiations Committee** – Mr. Smith reported the JTEA and Administration have both signed a Memorandum of Agreement.
