**WHERAS**, the Jefferson Township Board of Education (Board) desires to appoint a broker of record to represent the Board in matters relating to employee health, prescription, vision and dental benefits, and

**WHEREAS**, Brown and Brown Benefit Advisors ("Consultant") has offered to provide broker of record services relating to employee health, prescription and dental plans, and

**WHEREAS**, the Consultant has requested proposals from various insurance companies for our district's medical and prescription plans, and

**WHEREAS**, the Consultant has negotiated a competitive renewal with the existing carrier ("Aetna") on behalf of the District and,

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board appoint Brown & Brown Benefit Advisors, as the Board's broker of record for the period of July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 for matters relating to employee medical, prescription, vision and dental benefits.

**WHEREAS**, the aforementioned statutes authorize procedures, under the authority of the Commissioner of Education, which permit a board of education to transfer unexpended appropriations into reserve accounts during the month of June by board resolution, and

**WHEREAS**, the Jefferson Board of Education wishes to transfer unexpended appropriations from the general fund into a **Capital Reserve** account at year end, and

**WHEREAS**, the Jefferson Board of Education has determined that an amount not to exceed \$500,000 is available for such purpose of transfer;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Jefferson Board of Education that it hereby authorizes the district's School Business Administrator to make this transfer consistent with all applicable laws and regulations.

- **L.11** Motion to approve the Title transfer of ownership of one 54-passenger school bus, VIN# 4DRBUAAP2AB227822, to Jefferson Township, for the consideration of \$1.00, upon availability of replacement vehicle.
- **L.12** Motion to participate in Joint Transportation Agreement with Roxbury Township Board of Education whereby the Roxbury Township Board of Education shall serve as the Host District providing services to the Jefferson Township Board of Education (Joiner District) for the transportation of students to Roxbury High School, Succasunna, NJ, at a total cost of \$3,630.00 for the period of July 1 through August 30, 2018. **BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Board of Education of the Township of Jefferson in the County of Morris, New Jersey (with not less than a majority of the full membership of the board concurring) as follows:

1. It is hereby determined that a proposal shall be submitted for voter approval at a special school district election to be held on October 2, 2018 between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. as permitted and required by law. The form of the proposal shall read substantially as follows with such adjustments as may be provided by bond counsel:

#### **PROPOSAL**

The Board of Education of the Township of Jefferson in the County of Morris, New Jersey is authorized: (a) to undertake renovations, alterations and improvements at Jefferson Township High School, Jefferson Township Middle School, Ellen T. Briggs School, Cozy Lake School, Milton School, Arthur Stanlick School and White Rock School, including fixtures, furnishings, equipment, site work and related work; (b) to appropriate \$9,935,000 for such purposes; and (c) to issue bonds of the school district in the principal amount of \$9,935,000.

The final eligible costs of the projects approved by the Commissioner of Education are \$9,935,000 (with \$4,707,625 allocated to Jefferson High School, \$2,471,720 allocated to Jefferson Middle School, \$695,160 allocated to Briggs School, \$396,800 allocated to Cozy Lake School, \$126,800 allocated to Milton School, \$577,840 allocated to Arthur Stanlick School and \$959,055 allocated to White Rock School). The proposed improvements include \$0 for school construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). The State debt service aid percentage will equal 40% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the projects. The Board of Education is authorized to transfer funds among the projects approved at this special election.

- 2. This Board of Education hereby approves and adopts the proposal set forth above, and, subject to the approval of the legal voters of the school district, hereby determines to carry out the improvements described therein (the "Projects").
- 3. This Board of Education hereby acknowledges and confirms that in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:24-16 and 18A:24-17 a supplemental debt statement has been prepared by the chief financial officer of the Township of Jefferson (the "Township"), giving effect to the proposed authorization of bonds of the school district in the maximum amount of bonds authorized in the proposal. The supplemental debt statement has been filed in the office of the Township Clerk and in the office of the Business Administrator/Board Secretary of this Board of Education prior to the adoption of the proposal and will be filed in the office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs prior to the date of the special election.
- 4. The Business Administrator/Board Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to send a certified copy of the proposal to the County Clerk as required by N.J.S.A. 19:60-2, to request the County Clerk to submit the proposal to the voters at the special school district election and to seek the assistance of the county officials and the municipal clerk in conducting the special school district election.
- 5. The Board of Education hereby acknowledges receipt of the Final Eligible Costs (FEC) letters for the Projects from the Department of Education. The Board hereby elects to receive debt service aid pursuant to Section 9 of the Educational Facilities Construction and Financing Act, N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-1 et seq. (the "Act"). The Board further agrees to accept the determination of the preliminary eligible costs as final eligible costs as set forth in the PEC letters by the Department of Education and not to appeal. The Business Administrator/Board Secretary is authorized, if necessary, to notify the Department of Education of the Board's election with respect to the eligible costs and its election to receive debt service aid.
- 6. Gianforcaro Architects, Engineers & Planners, the School District's appointed architect for the Projects (the "Project Architect"), has heretofore been authorized and delegated the responsibility to prepare the plans and specifications for the Projects in consultation with and under the supervision of the Business Administrator/Board Secretary, who has heretofore been delegated the responsibility to work with the Project Architect for this purpose on behalf of the Board of Education, in accordance with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-16, and such authorizations and delegations are hereof reconfirmed.
- 7. The educational plans, where required, and the schematic plans for the construction of the Projects have heretofore been approved by this Board of Education, and such approval is hereby reconfirmed.
- 8. The Board President, the Superintendent of Schools, the Business Administrator/Board Secretary, the Project Architect, Bond Counsel and other appropriate representatives of the Board of Education (the "Board Representatives") have heretofore been authorized, and such authorization is hereby

- reconfirmed, to submit the educational plans, where required, and the schematic plans for the Projects, together with such other information as may be required, to the State Department of Education for approval and to make application to the Commissioner of Education for approval of the educational plans, where required, the schematic plans and the Projects and, if necessary, any required amendment to the long-range facilities plan, in accordance with the requirements of the Act and N.J.A.C. 6A:26-2.1(f), 6A:26-2.3, 6A:26-3.1 and 6A:26-3.2.
- 9. The Board Representatives have heretofore been and are hereby further authorized and directed to submit the plans and any other required information to the Planning Board and the Department of Environmental Protection for review and comment, if necessary, and such authorization and direction are hereby reconfirmed.
- 10. This Board of Education hereby makes the following covenants and declarations with respect to obligations determined to be issued by the Business Administrator/Board Secretary through a public offering or private placement or through a conduit borrower on a tax-exempt basis. The Board of Education hereby covenants that it will comply with any conditions subsequent imposed by the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), in order to preserve the exemption from taxation of interest on its bonds or notes if issued as tax exempt, including, if necessary, the requirement to rebate all net investment earnings on the gross proceeds above the yield on its bonds or notes. The Business Administrator/Board Secretary is hereby authorized to act on behalf of the Board of Education to deem the obligations authorized herein as bank qualified for the purposes of Section 265 of the Code, when appropriate. The Board of Education hereby declares the intent of the Board of Education to issue bonds or temporary notes in the amount not to exceed the amount set forth in the bond proposal approved by the voters as set forth in Section 1 and to use the proceeds to pay or to reimburse expenditures for the costs of the school capital projects authorized therein. This resolution is a declaration of intent within the meaning and for purposes of Treasury Regulations §1.150-2 or any successor provisions of federal income tax law.
- 11. The Board Representatives are hereby authorized to take all steps necessary to implement this resolution. Any actions authorized herein and taken prior hereto are hereby ratified. The Business Administrator/Board Secretary is further authorized to act on behalf of the Board of Education to make such determinations required of the Board of Education for the conduct of the election as may become necessary.
- 12. The reference to officers of this school district herein includes any interim, acting or successor officer holding that position.
- 13. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
