  - e) Waive these rules when necessary for the protection of privacy or the efficient administration of the Board's business.

In addition, by law, administrators and Board of Education members are not permitted to publicly discuss personnel matters, student discipline, or other issues requiring confidentiality. - 2. These matters will be disclosed to the public as soon as the need for confidentiality no longer applies.
