 - d) Call for a recess or an adjournment to another time when the lack of public decorum so interferes with the orderly conduct of the meeting as to warrant such action; and
 - e) Waive these rules when necessary for the protection of privacy or the efficient administration of the Board's business.

Please note that "Comments from the Audience" is not a time for dialogue – it is an opportunity for you to share a comment with the Board of Education. In addition, by law, administrators and Board of Education members are not permitted to publicly discuss personnel matters, student discipline, or other issues requiring confidentiality. While we may not respond to your comments, all input shared with the Board of Education is taken very seriously, and will be discussed at future deliberations by the Board of Education and its Committees.

J.9 Motion to approve resolution authorizing execution of agreement with the **Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council** to renew membership therein for the period of October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2026.

WHEREAS, the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council (MCCPC) was created in 1974 to conduct a voluntary cooperative pricing system with municipalities, boards of education and other public bodies located in the County of Morris and adjoining counties; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the MCCPC, which is administered by Randolph Township as Lead Agency, to renew its membership in the MCCPC for the period of October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2026.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Jefferson Township Board of Education, County of Morris, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Business Administrator of the Jefferson Township Board of Education hereby authorizes the execution of an agreement with the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council by the Township of Randolph as Lead Agency dated October 1, 2021 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11(5). Said agreement is for renewal of membership in the MCCPC for a five (5) year period from October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2026.
2. The Jefferson Township Board of Education Clerk is hereby directed to submit a copy of this adopted resolution, along with an executed agreement, to Randolph Township as Lead Agency of the MCCPC.
3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon final passage according to law.
4. All appropriate Jefferson Township Board of Education officials are authorized and directed to perform all required acts to affect the purpose of this resolution.
