Mrs. Howe reported on the Good News and Progress in our schools. Dr. Jinks, Assistant Superintendent, provided an update on the Health and Physical Education curriculum process.

J. **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Education Committee - Mrs. Wildermuth reported the Committee met on July 11, 2022 and discussed the Comprehensive Health & Physical Education Curriculum revisions, noting the curriculum is fairly general in nature, with an opt in/opt out included in the parent portal. The Committee also reviewed the district wellness report, drug and alcohol survey at the MS/HS, preschool expansion program, and approval of day field trips.

Mrs. Gould inquired about the ability to see the content of the health and physical education

curriculum revisions in advance.

Mrs. Perez asked if the August 4, 2022 forum would be recorded. Mrs. Howe responded that it would be live streamed.

Mrs. Perez also asked a question regarding the drug and alcohol survey.

Mrs. Gould commented on the significance of free and reduced lunch application process to many areas including PEA eligibility and prioritization.

Personnel and Policy Committee - Mrs. Perez reported the Committee met on July 11, 2022 and discussed policies and regulations, job descriptions, SLEO hiring, assistant principal search, preschool expansion grant, and open positions in the district.

Mrs. Howe addressed a question during the public comment period about student smoking and loss of co-curricular privileges.

Mrs. Gould inquired about the Assistant Principal interview process.

- Community Relations Mr. Natale reported the Committee did not meet this month.

 Building Needs and Finance Committee Mr. Terpstra highlighted the July 12, 2022 minutes, noting the Committee discussed the preschool expansion aide, health benefits advisor, high school bank branch update, district banking services, 22-23 meal prices, and the HVAC bid

Mrs. Gould had several comments regarding health benefits and food service and asked if it would be beneficial to request additional proposals for each service.




