**WHEREAS**, the Board authorizes the Financial Adviser to solicit bids or proposals to finance the Equipment pursuant to a lease purchase agreement to finance the Equipment; and

**WHEREAS**, the Financial Advisor will mail bid documents, if necessary, or proposal solicitations to firms that purchase tax-exempt governmental leases, and such bids or proposals will be returned to the School Business Administrator/Board Secretary, who with the assistance of the Financial Advisor, will determine the lowest net interest rate for the lease from the prospective purchaser of the lease.

Upon adoption of the Resolution the Board may enter into a contract with Phoenix Advisors, LLC to perform such services as described in the resolution and in further detail in the contract.

**J.14** Motion to award the Lease/Purchase bid to Bank of America, in the amount of \$890,525.00, at an interest rate of 3.1292%. (Bid Breakdown Sheet attached)

Resolution of the Board of Education of the Township of Jefferson in the County of Morris, New Jersey determining to purchase school vehicles and technology equipment through the execution of a lease purchase agreement, approving the form of certain agreements and authorizing certain officials of the Board to execute such agreements, ratifying all prior actions taken by the Board with respect to this transaction and authorizing other actions necessary to accomplish this transaction:

**WHEREAS**, The Board of Education of the Township of Jefferson in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Board") has determined to finance the acquisition of new school vehicles and technology equipment and all related costs (collectively, the "Equipment") through a lease purchase transaction for a term not to exceed five (5) years; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has selected Phoenix Advisors, LLC. to serve as financial advisor (the "Financial Advisor") and McManimon & Scotland, L.L.C., to serve as Special Counsel (the "Special Counsel") for the purpose of preparing bid and closing documents for a lease purchase financing for the acquisition of the Equipment (collectively, the "Professionals"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has followed the procedures required by *N.J.S.A.* 18A:18A-1 et seq., and the regulations promulgated there under; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board authorized the Financial Advisor to solicit bids for the financing of the Equipment pursuant to a lease purchase agreement to finance the Equipment for an amount of approximately \$890,525 for a period of not to exceed five (5) years; and

**WHEREAS**, bids were solicited on or about May 22, 2009 and such bids were returned to the Business Administrator/Board Secretary on or before June 3, 2009, who, with the assistance of the Financial Advisor and Special Counsel, determined the lowest responsive bidder that will purchase the lease from the Board (hereinafter the "Purchaser"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Board will enter into a lease purchase agreement and other related documents with the Purchaser for an amount of approximately \$890,525 to finance the acquisition of the Equipment; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board desires to award the lease purchase agreement to Bank of America as the lowest responsive bidder and to authorize the Board President, the Business Administrator/Board Secretary, Special Counsel and the Financial Advisor to prepare and execute the appropriate lease documents and certain other agreements necessary or incidental to the transactions contemplated thereby;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Education of the Township of Jefferson he County of Morris, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Board hereby determines to finance the Equipment by means of a lease purchase financing in a principal amount of approximately \$890,525 for a five (5) year term (the "Lease") in accordance with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-1 *et seq.* (the "Public School Contracts Law"). The Business Administrator/Board Secretary, the Financial Advisor, the Special Counsel and other appropriate representatives of the Board (the "Professionals") are hereby authorized to prepare the necessary timetables and bid documents and other related documents as may be necessary and to take other steps necessary to prepare for the proposed financing.

Section 2. The Professionals are authorized to publish a request for bid in accordance with the requirements of the Public School Contracts Law in order to prepare for the proposed transaction and all actions taken by the Professionals prior to the date hereof with respect to the publication and preparation of the request for bid are hereby ratified and affirmed.

Section 3. The Board hereby awards the bid to Bank of America, for a rate of 3.129% with a five year repayment term, as the lowest responsive bidder pursuant to the advertised request for

bids and hereby authorizes the Board President and/or the Business Administrator/Board Secretary to negotiate and to execute contracts and documents in order to facilitate the closing of this t transaction subject to review of Special Counsel, including specifically the Lease and such other documents as may be necessary to consummate the transaction. The Board President and the Business Administrator/Board Secretary are also authorized and directed to take on behalf of the Board such other actions as shall be necessary and appropriate to accomplish the lease purchase financing for the Equipment in accordance with the terms of the Lease and this resolution and pursuant to the terms of the agreements and instruments authorized to be prepared hereby and to accomplish the performance of the obligations of the Board in respect thereto.

Section 4. The Board hereby authorizes the execution and the delivery of and the performance by the Board of its obligations under the Lease and other related financing documents, which shall be substantially in the form on file with the Business Administrator/Board Secretary. The Board hereby authorizes and directs the Board President, Superintendent and the Business Administrator/Board Secretary to approve any changes, additions or deletions to the Lease as may, in the judgment of Special Counsel, be necessary or advisable, such approval to be evidenced by the execution of the Lease by the Board President, the Superintendent and the Business Administrator/Board Secretary.

Section 5. The Lease sets forth the term of the lease purchase acquisition by the Board for the acquisition of the Equipment, the rental payments to be paid by the Board in respect thereof and the dates on which rents shall be due and payable.

Section 6. The proceeds of the sale of the Lease shall be applied to (i) pay costs to acquire the Equipment, and (ii) pay the costs of entering into the Lease.

Section 7. The Business Administrator/Board Secretary is authorized to direct the investment of funds under an escrow deposit agreement (the "Escrow Agreement") between the Board and an escrow agent, if required, in connection with the Bid Proposal, such escrow agent to be determined by the Business Administrator/Board Secretary, consistent with the provisions of New Jersey law, and is authorized to enter into such Escrow Agreement and to execute such documents on behalf of the Board as may be necessary therefor.

Section 8. The Board hereby covenants that it will comply with any conditions subsequent imposed by the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), in order to preserve the exemption from taxation of the interest portion of the rental payments under the Lease, including the requirement to rebate all net investment earnings on the gross proceeds above the yield on the Lease. The Lease is hereby designated as a "qualified tax-exempt obligation" for purposes of Section 265(b)(3)(ii) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to execute and to deliver on behalf of the Board the agreements referred to herein and any such other agreements or documents as may be necessary to carry out the transaction authorized by this resolution. The Board President, Superintendent, Business Administrator/Board Secretary, Special Counsel and other appropriate representatives of the Board are hereby authorized and directed to take on behalf of the Board such other actions as shall be necessary and appropriate to accomplish the transaction contemplated by this resolution and the agreements authorized herein.

Section 10. All actions taken by the Board President, Superintendent, Business Administrator/Board Secretary, Special Counsel or Financial Advisor prior to the date hereof to effect the transactions contemplated by the Lease and this resolution are hereby ratified and affirmed in all respects. Any prior resolution adopted by the Board with respect to the transactions contemplated herein is hereby amended to the extent of any inconsistency herewith and all other terms and conditions of such prior resolutions remain in full force and effect.

Section 11. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
