WHEREAS, said boiler may have to be replaced during the 2008/2009 heating season if it ceases to function properly;

WHEREAS, while a temporary mobile boiler is available and ready to go into operation, this Board believes that the existing boiler at Ellen T. Briggs Elementary School should be replaced as soon as possible and that this proposed project meets the requirements for Level 1 funding under the Grant Program because it is an essential building systems upgrade;

WHEREAS, under the Grant Program's requirements, this Board must file its application for funding with the Department by November 20, 2008, if it is to receive funding under the Grant Program in the near future.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Jefferson Township Board of Education that its staff is hereby authorized to file an application with the New Jersey Department of Education seeking Level 1 funding under the Grant Program to be used for replacement of the boiler at the Ellen T. Briggs Elementary School.
