SUMMER IS AN IMPORTANT TIME FOR STUDENTS TO KEEP THEIR MATH SKILLS SHARP. WE ENCOURAGE YOU TO HELP YOUR CHILD ENGAGE IN MATH ACTIVITIES FOR ENJOYMENT OVER THE SUMMER BREAK.

"SUMMER SLIDE" DOES NOT JUST OCCUR WITH READING. ACTUALLY, MATH SUMMER SLIDE IS OFTEN MORE COMMON THAN READING. ON AVERAGE STUDENTS FORGET APPROXIMATELY TWO MONTHS WORTH OF MATH SKILLS EVERY SUMMER.

MATH SUMMER SLIDE CAN BE AVOIDED BY ENCOURAGIN YOUR CHILD TO PRACTICE MATH ON A WEEKLY BASIS. STUDENTS WHO PRACTICE THEIR MATH SKILLS OVER THE SUMMER, EXPERIENCE A SMOOTH TRANSITION BACK TO MATH CLASS EACH YEAR!
