If you already have a Community Pass account, sign in and register for the Recreation Department's busing option to and from Mt. Creek and White Rock or Arthur Stanlick Elementary Schools, the Jefferson Township Middle School, or the Jefferson Township High School). If not, an adult (over 18) must follow the prompts to set up a personal account in Community Pass and then add the student's information to register him/her for the Jefferson Township Recreation Department's Mt. Creek round-trip busing for the six Thursday trip dates. Make sure you update the student's grade and school information on Community Pass and choose the season "2020 Mt. Creek after school program" and register for the child's specific school. The parent will automatically receive an email confirmation after registering and making the \$90 payment.

- If a trip in the 6-trip schedule must be cancelled due to inclement weather, an announcement will be made in the Jefferson Township Middle/High Schools and the Arthur Stanlick/White Rock Elementary Schools by 12 noon. Rescheduled dates may NOT be on a Thursday if approaching the end of the season.
- Students may bring skis OR a snowboard directly to school the morning of each trip for storage as designated by the respective school office (but NOT on the school bus!).
- New Jersey State Law requires all ski/snowboard participants age 17 and under to wear a ski helmet when on the trails and lifts. However, Jefferson Township Recreation requires that ALL SKIERS/BOARDERS IN THEIR AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM WEAR HELMETS!
- All first-time skiers/snowboarders are required to take lessons through the Mountain Creek Ride & Ski School at no extra charge on each of the six trip dates.
- Motor coach buses will leave directly from the Jefferson Township Middle School and High School at dismissal at 2:35 PM and return to each school parking lot at approximately 9:30 PM. A First Student bus will leave directly from the Arthur Stanlick School and the Camp Jefferson Recreation Department bus will leave directly from the White Rock Elementary School at dismissal at 3:20 PM and return to each school parking lot at approximately 8:45 PM.
