WHEREAS, The Board has approved that there should be raised for the General Fund a tax levy of \$38,389,377, which includes \$331,899 of Banked Cap for the ensuing School Year (2014-2015) to offset the Cozy Lake Elementary School boiler replacement, which cannot be deferred or incrementally completed over a longer period of time.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Jefferson Board of Education, in the County of Morris, New Jersey approves that the unused, unexpired taxing authority of \$374,551, be banked for potential use in the subsequent allowable fiscal years.
