G. FINANCE AND BUILDING NEEDS COMMITTEE

G.1 RESOLVED, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, that the Jefferson Township Board of Education, in the County of Morris, New Jersey approves resolutions G.1-G.4, as described below:

BE IT RESOLVED, to approve a 2011-2012 school district preliminary budget for submission to the voters as follows:

General Fund	\$ 53,653,554
Special Revenue Fund	\$ 825,281
Debt Service Fund	\$ 2,079,905

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there should be raised for the General Fund \$36,430,593 for the ensuing School Year (2011-2012); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Education approves the following capital projects for the 2011-2012 school year:

G.2 WHEREAS, school district policy and N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.3(a) provides that the Board of Education shall establish in the annual school budget a maximum expenditure amount that may be allotted for such travel and expense reimbursement for the 2011-2012 school year; and

WHEREAS, maximum expenditure amount allotted for travel and expense reimbursement for the 2010-2011 school year was \$77,011; and

WHEREAS, travel and expense reimbursement has reached a total amount \$53,280 as of March 1, 2011;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Jefferson Township Board of Education, in the County of Morris, New Jersey hereby establishes the school district travel maximum for the 2011-2012 school year at the sum of \$70,680; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the School Business Administrator shall track and record these costs to insure that the maximum amount is not exceeded

G.3 WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 6A:23A:5.2 (a) mandates boards to establish annually prior to budget preparation, for public relations and each type of professional service a maximum level of spending for the ensuring school year; and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget includes the following appropriations

WHEREAS, the Board and Administration wishes to minimize the amount of paperwork involved in this area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Jefferson Township Board of Education establishes maximums for professional development in the areas listed above at a level of 120% of the amounts listed for the 2011-2012 school year.
