Resolution Of The Board Of Education Of The Township Of Jefferson In The County Of Morris, New Jersey Making Application To The Local Finance Board Pursuant To N.J.S.A. 18A:24-61 ET SEQ.

WHEREAS, The Board of Education of the Township of Jefferson in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the “Board of Education”) desires to make application to the Local Finance Board for its approval of a refunding bond ordinance authorizing the issuance of not exceeding \$24,000,000 Refunding School Bonds pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:24-61 et seq. in order to provide debt service savings for the school district; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education believes that:

- (a) it is in the public interest to accomplish such purpose;
- (b) the purpose is for the health, the welfare, the convenience or the betterment of the inhabitants of the school district;
- (c) the amounts to be expended for the purpose or the improvements are not unreasonable or exorbitant; and
- (d) the proposal is an efficient and feasible means of providing services for the needs of the inhabitants of the school district and will not create an undue financial burden to be placed upon the school district;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By The Board Of Education Of The Township Of Jefferson In The County Of Morris as follows:

Section 1. The application to the Local Finance Board is hereby approved, and the Board of Education's Bond Counsel, along with other representatives of the Board of Education, are hereby authorized to prepare such application and to represent the Board of Education in matters pertaining thereto.

Section 2. The Business Administrator/Board Secretary of the Board of Education is hereby directed to prepare and to file a certified copy of the financing documents authorizing the Bonds with the Local Finance Board as part of such application.

Section 3. The Local Finance Board is hereby respectfully requested to consider such application and to record its findings and approval as provided by the applicable New Jersey Statute.

J.15 Resolution Of The Board Of Education Of The Township Of Jefferson In The County Of Morris, New Jersey Authorizing Agreement For Financial Advisory Services.

WHEREAS, there exists a need for specialized financial advisory services in connection with the authorization and the issuance of Refunding School Bonds by The Board of Education of the Township of Jefferson in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Board of Education"), a body corporate of the State of New Jersey; including the review and compilation of financial and demographic information of the Board; obtaining the appropriate credit enhancements for the refunding bonds, if any; structuring the various terms and conditions associated with the refunding bonds in order to maximize the interest savings and general advice to the Board of Education about the various financial aspects of the bond issue, and

WHEREAS, such services are advisory in nature, are services for which it is not reasonably possible to draft specifications and therefore are deemed to be extraordinary and unspecifiable, and Phoenix Advisors, LLC has the expertise, extensive training and proven reputation and has demonstrated capability and valuable assistance in providing such advice and services; and

WHEREAS, funds are or will be available for this purpose;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved By The Board Of Education Of The Township Of Jefferson In The County Of Morris, New Jersey As Follows:

Section 1. The firm of Phoenix Advisors, LLC is hereby retained to provide financial advisory services necessary in connection with the authorization and the issuance of the refunding bonds by the Board of Education in accordance with an agreement dated as of September 20, 2010 and submitted to the Board of Education (the "Contract").

Section 2. The Contract is awarded without competitive bidding as an extraordinary unspecifiable service in accordance with the Public School Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-5(a)(2) because it is for services of an advisory nature.

Section 3. A notice in accordance with the Public School Contracts Law of New Jersey in the form attached hereto shall be published in The Daily Record.

Section 4. A copy of this resolution as well as the Contract shall be placed on file with the Business Administrator/Board Secretary of the Board of Education.

Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

Q. BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

- Mr. Vander Ploeg stated he hopes the public board meetings continue to be well attended.
- Mr. Feldmann noted that the Board has accomplished much and continues to seek ways to improve operations. He also felt the board was unfairly labeled during the past months and requested that judgment be held until litigation is resolved. He encouraged the public to seek Board of Education seats. He also stated there is a different perspective sitting on that side.
- Mrs. Scott welcomed the new staff. She also noted the Board will conduct a superintendent and self evaluation at a public meeting on Oct. 25. Mrs. Scott commented that she was disappointed in not being able to attend the staff orientation.

R. COMMENTS FROM THE AUDIENCE

- A PTA President thanked the PTA for their role and asked the Board of Education to recognize other groups such as booster clubs, etc.
- An audience member commented on the homecoming game, marching band and sought clarification on an employees travel request.
- The question arose when the new social studies supervisor would start and how it would impact the teaching role.
- An update on an OPRA request was made. It was noted that the current legal bills had not yet received. It was also asked why the coaching position was not discussed in Executive Session. Mrs. Scott responded that they could only discuss this if an employee had been given a notice.
- Several members of the audience spoke of the issues surrounding and in support of the former high school soccer coach, noting that the public is dissatisfied with the process.
- Mrs. Scott spoke regarding the August meeting, noting that comments were misconstrued. She commented that the Board is listening to public sentiment and urged the public and fellow Board members to keep an open dialogue.
- An audience member commented on an issue with the transportation department regarding bus stops and drop offs.
- An audience member questioned which comments were “misconstrued” and requested an explanation.
- A member of the audience commented that the public has lost trust in the Board and likened the coaching situation to Pandora’s Box, noting that the integrity of the Board was lost.
- Members of the high school soccer team spoke about their last game, noting that they felt something was missing.
- One audience member noted that they had observed some dissention regarding the support of Mr. Reid as soccer coach and commented that he could offer some insight into why he was not reappointed.
- Mrs. Scott was asked about her abstention vote during the May 15 meeting. Mrs. Scott commented that her opinion, after careful review of the Board Member Code of Ethics, varied from that of the Board’s attorney and therefore abstained.
- Concerned with protocol, an audience member noted that we should move forward in positive direction.
- Students continued to speak in support of Coach Reid.
