JEFFERSON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A TRIAL BASIS SENIOR OPEN CAMPUS LUNCH FOR THE 2022-2023

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, the Jefferson Township Board of Education desires to implement a senior open campus on a trial basis for the remainder of the 2022-2023 school year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

Open Campus Lunch Policies are for eligible students in their Senior Year of Jefferson Township High School. Eligible seniors must submit the Open Campus Lunch Permission and Application Form for approval. Senior open lunch is a privilege that will be open to students who meet the following guidelines:

- 1. Seniors who are in good academic standing and attendance, i.e., have the appropriate number of credits to be considered a senior and maintain a 2.0 GPA, maintain attendance in accordance with school policies, and be current with all student accounts will be eligible. Students placed on academic probation or have low attendance, truant, etc. will lose their eligibility for Open Lunch. Students who come to school tardy (unexcused) will lose the open campus privilege for the day.
- 2. Seniors must have a good discipline record; this aspect of the application will be evaluated by Jefferson Township High School administration.
- 3. Students must submit a notarized application form, with a parent's signature, releasing the school from liability. Students above the "Age of Majority" (18 years old) must sign this clause as well.
- 4. Students with open campus lunch privileges will have an open campus lunch identification card (student ID) and must have the card with them at all times while off-campus.
- 5. Each student with open campus lunch privileges is responsible for their own transportation.
- 6. Students who do not return to campus on time or who fail to report to class on time may result in the loss of open campus lunch privileges, in accordance with school attendance policies. The failure to return to class following lunch will be treated as a cut.
- 7. Students may not transport any student who does not have open campus lunch privileges.
- 8. Students who utilize a motor vehicle during open campus lunch must demonstrate compliance with the New Jersey State Law and have a valid driver's license with valid registration on the vehicle. Any loss of driving privileges must be reported to the school administration.
- 9. Students will be required to inform the school of their driver's license, license plate, registration, insurance card, and make/model/year of the vehicle they will use for open campus lunch privileges.
- 10. The privilege is subject to being temporarily or permanently revoked if a Senior fails to wear or display an ID, or fails to return to campus on time for the next class, or engages in any conduct that would violate the School's Code of Conduct.
- 11. Students are strictly prohibited from bringing back food to be eaten by or shared with students inside the school

12. Any student caught using tobacco, drugs, or tobacco or drug related materials in school or while away from campus, or any student that has a positive drug screen will have the privilege revoked for the remainder of the school year.

Eligible seniors will have to present their Jefferson Township High School Open Campus Lunch ID cards when exiting the school building and returning to the school building from lunch. Seniors will be allowed to depart from the building only following Block C and must return before the start of Block D in time so as not to be late to Block D.

Seniors with this privilege will be held to high expectations outside of Jefferson Township High School. Proper behavior on the road, school parking lot, and in the community is expected at all times. In addition to compliance with all school rules and regulations, students must abide by state, county, and local traffic laws.

Consequences or violation of any policies, rules, or regulations will be at the discretion of Jefferson Township High School administration. Consequences beyond the student handbook may include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Administrative warning;
- 2. Two (2) week suspension of privileges;
- 3. Revocation of privileges.

Jefferson Township High School administration has the right to prohibit students from leaving due to dangerous or inclement weather (heavy rain, thunderstorm, tornado, hurricane, snow, ice, etc.), safety or security reasons, traffic patterns, outbursts of disruptive or disorderly behavior by the students, or any other circumstance deemed appropriate. Also, students will not be allowed to leave for open campus lunch during half-days or special schedule days (assembly, delayed opening, etc.).

This resolution will take effect on May 8, 2023.
