 - d) Call for a recess or an adjournment to another time when the lack of public decorum so interferes with the orderly conduct of the meeting as to warrant such action; and
 - e) Waive these rules when necessary for the protection of privacy or the efficient administration of the Board's business.

Please note that "Comments from the Audience" is not a time for dialogue – it is an opportunity for you to share a comment with the Board of Education. In addition, by law, administrators and Board of Education members are not permitted to publicly discuss personnel matters, student discipline, or other issues requiring confidentiality. WHEREAS, the Board has approved that there should be raised for the General Fund a tax levy of \$48,940,863, inclusive of adjustments totaling \$329,660,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Education includes in the tentative budget the adjustment for enrollment in the amount of \$175,347. The district intends to utilize this adjustment to maintain staffing and curricular expenditures, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board of Education includes in the tentative budget the adjustment for banked cap in the amount of \$154,313. In accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-10.3(b), the district has fully exhausted all eligible statutory spending authority. The adjustment will be used to maintain staffing and curricular expenditures. The Board of Education will incur these expenditures by June 30, 2025 and acknowledges that they cannot be deferred or incrementally completed over a longer period of time.

K.3 *BE IT RESOLVED*, the Board of Education includes in the 2024-2025 budget a capital reserve withdrawal in the amount of \$1,385,320 for:

- Partial Funding of the Roof Replacement Project at White Rock Elementary School
- Paving of the Bus Compound Parking Lot

K.4 *WHEREAS*, school district policy and N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.3(a) provides the Jefferson Township Board of Education shall establish in the annual school budget a maximum expenditure amount that may be allotted for such travel and expense reimbursement for the 2024-2025 school year; and

WHEREAS, maximum expenditure amount allotted for travel and expense reimbursement for the 2023-2024 school year was \$103,094; and

WHEREAS, travel and expense reimbursement has reached a total amount of \$47,326 as of March 15, 2024,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Jefferson Township Board of Education, in the County of Morris, New Jersey hereby establishes the school district travel maximum for the 2024-2025 at the sum of \$110,776, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the School Business Administrator shall track and record these costs to ensure that the maximum amount is not exceeded.
